Public School's Universal TK

What is Universal Transitional Kindergarten (TK)

UTK is a public program for children aged 3.8 but are not eligible for Kindergarten yet. It is a newer program and has not yet worked out all the details of functionality. And although it is "universal" there are priority lists for application and not everyone can "get in" to where they want.
